"Easter"

We are nearing the time of year
when most everyone is thinking about Easter,
and in contemplating that day, I wrote the following:

"You speak of the bunny and the egg,
but your pardon I must beg.
Could you explain this? I'm at a loss!
What's the connection to the cross?"

It was Jesus who suffered and died;
on a cross, He was crucified. That
He has risen, I have no doubt, for
that's what Easter should be about!

Then as I think about the cruel way Jesus was hung
on that cross and left to die, I wonder;

Had I been there, when they nailed
Jesus to the cross, would I have
joined the crowd, or quietly mourned
the loss? Could I, like Peter, have
three times denied, as He hung there
in sorrow, just before He died?
I'd like to think that my feelings would
have been so intense, that I'd have the
courage to come to His defense! But
it's very likely that I may have been so
shy, I'd wait in the shadows and sadly
watch Him die!

But now that He has risen, could it be
each time I sin, that I hurt Him again so
deeply, like driving the nails back in?
